Outreach Sessions



On 4th November 2022, Ms. Honey Garg, convenor of the EDC cell, Ms. Suman, and Ms. Rani Jindal of Govt organized an entrepreneurship and start-up awareness camp. PG College for Women Sector 14, Panchkula, with the participation of 103 Arts students. Tanushree Chandra and Pankaj Singh from the Panchkula Startup Incubator Centre led the students toward the Entrepreneurship & Startup Ecosystem.



The Startup Incubator Cum Centre of Excellence, Panchkula, was invited by Govt. College Barwala to host an awareness session for their students on 7th November 2022. The main goal of this session was to inspire the students to learn about entrepreneurship as a potential career path and to pursue careers in business. The Entrepreneurial and Training Placement Cell of the College, headed by Ms. Harshvanda and Dr. Mamta Rani, successfully organized this session with the support of Principal Dr. Richa Setia. The students engaged fully in all the activities the Incubator team was running. Teachers at Barwala College pointed students in the direction of various business concepts. The session's outcome was that some students had good business ideas and understood how they were implemented.

Outreach Sessions



On 17th November 2022, Startup Incubator Cum Centre of Excellence, Panchkula, hosted an awareness session at Govt P.G. College Sector-1, Panchkula, with the assistance of the Psychology Department. The primary goal of this session was to inspire the students to pursue business careers. The lesson was structured so the students could comprehend the significance of developing ideas and turning them into successful businesses. We assisted them in making the connection between how psychology as a discipline can be used to develop concepts such as creating journals, planners, counseling platforms, etc.



Smt. Aruna Asif Ali College, Kalka's ED Cell, hosted a one-day workshop on entrepreneurship on 10th November 2022, in collaboration with Startup Incubator Cum Centre of Excellence, Panchkula. Mr. Vineet Khurana, CEO of SACC India, was invited to this workshop as the keynote speaker, inspiring the students to pursue careers in business. He led the students through a half-baked exercise in which he divided the participants into six teams, assisted them in identifying problems in their immediate environment, and asked them to develop solutions based on five criteria: problem statement, solution (product or service), the unique value proposition of the product or service, sale strategy, and the investment needed to launch that idea. In this workshop, Kalka College students actively participated, gained inspiration, and developed solid business ideas.

Outreach Sessions



To dispel the myth that only students majoring in commerce can launch businesses, the Department of Science at Govt P.G. College sector-14 in Panchkula organised an awareness session on 11th November 2022, in collaboration with Startup Incubator Cum Centre of Excellence.

The students enthusiastically engaged in the discussion and came up with ideas such as starting an organic lip balm business, a pet parlour, and online skill training courses. The students were so motivated that they actively participated in the discussion and suggested ideas for starting a pet parlour, an online skill training programme, and an organic lip balm business.



In collaboration with Startup Incubator Cum Centre of Excellence, Panchkula, the ED Cell of Govt P.G College sector-1, organised a workshop on entrepreneurship and the startup ecosystem for the Mass Communication Department on 29th November 2022.



Around 22 students from the first to the last year participated in this session. During an activity, we urged the students to consider the issues in their immediate environment and devise solutions. The students were informed about an upcoming programme that the Incubator is organising, where they will participate in a one-week online workshop. Thanks to this programme, they will learn how to convert their ideas into business plans.

Outreach Sessions



On 30th November 2022, we had an interactive session with computer science students from Govt P.G. College Sector-1, Panchkula, in their department to raise awareness of the college's startup incubator and its programs. Pankaj Singh, the outreach coordinator, and Tanushree Chandra, the center head, met with Ms. Kompal, the head of the computer science department, and gave her information about the six-day Ideakriti 2.0 event that will focus on entrepreneurship. The purpose of sharing all the details was to allow the students to sign up independently for the upcoming event.



On 30th November 2022, we had an interactive session with the Commerce Department of Govt P.G. College sector-14, Panchkula's students, to raise awareness of the Startup Incubator and its activities. Students were informed about the upcoming six-day event on entrepreneurship, Ideakriti 2.0, by outreach coordinator Pankaj Singh, Centre head Tanushree Chandra, and Honey Garg, the ED cell convener. All the information was made available to enable the students to sign up for the upcoming event.

Acceleration Activities



We support our student entrepreneurs at every stage. A student entrepreneur with the Hisar team who sells books and wants to join Amazon to increase her sales was given this support by Connecting with Ms. Charu from Amazon on 1st November 2022. Mr. Manjeet (the Hisar Outreach Coordinator) and Vanshika. Charu instructed them regarding the procedure and the necessary compliance for the onboarding procedure. They were also informed about the Amazon Saheli initiative for women sellers in length with its benefits.

Panchkula's startup incubator regularly gathers its startups to discuss their progress. We held a startup meeting on November 4, 2022, where we talked to our incubated startups about the opportunities that will help them grow their businesses. Startups from Nicky Raj Creations, Diva Damm, Amrit Dhra Potters, Merch Nest, BizdigiSol, Sashakt Nari Healthcare Products, and Nazakat were in attendance at the meeting. We also talked about communicating with different vendors, negotiating, delivering products, etc.



27 startups attended the Connect & Learn session at Startup in a Box, Mohali, a Co-working space for Startups. The session was a meetup of startup founders from Mohali and Panchkula at SIB in Mohali on November 9, 2022. Our startups had the chance to network with other business owners and receive advice to expand their network.



Acceleration Activities



Bootcamp Day 1 : 9th November 2022 – Connect & Learn

Startups from the Panchkula Center were invited to connect and learn at Startup in a Box, a co-working space in Mohali. To strengthen their network and gain knowledge from more seasoned startups and their experiences, they organized a Connect & Learn Session, which 14 startups from the Panchkula incubator attended.



Boot Camp Day 2: 10th November 2022– Case Study

On the second day of Boot Camp, which was on 10th November 2022, startup founders were given some case studies and discussed the problem statements of some startups as well as possible solutions. Nicky Raj Creations, Diva Damm, Amrit Dhra Potters, Merch Nest, Ys Chatkara, Sashakt Nari Healthcare Products, and Arty Kaushik's were among the startups in Boot camp.

Acceleration Activities



Our startups met with government representatives from the Department of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (Haryana) on 10th November 2022.

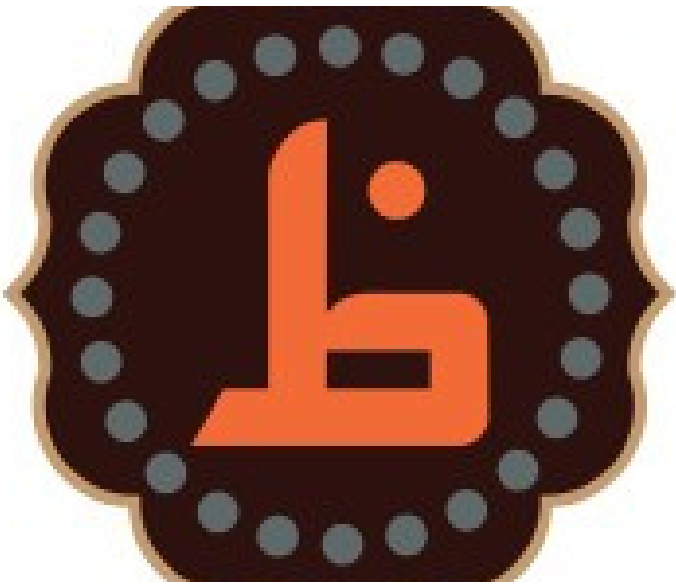

Boot Camp Day 3- 11th November 2022- Pitching Day

On 11th November 2022, Day 3 of Boot Camp was Startup Pitching Day. Startups from the Panchkula Startup Incubator Center presented their business plans to CA Vijender Singh, a judge and mentor at SACC India, founder of TaxReco- Tax Solutions. Startups from Nicky Raj Creations, Diva Damm, Amrit Dhra Potters, Merch Nest, Ys Chatkara, Sashakt Nari Healthcare Products, and Arty Kaushik's participated in the boot camp.

Acceleration Activities



To enhance the sales of our artisanal startups from SACC India, I got in touch with Mr. Samrat, the founder of Barkat Bazaar.

BarkatBazaar is a platform for the 1000's unique art forms of India, showcasing their beauty via home decor, home linen, fashion, and accessories.

Mr. Samrat discussed the Barkat Bazaar onboarding process, platform compliance requirements, and related terms and conditions.



CANNABLE 4.0, held on 26th November 2022, provided an opportunity for student entrepreneurs from our startup incubator cum center of excellence to attend and network. A significant gathering for startups across India. Decoding the success of a startup with or without startup funding was made possible by the theme "Demystifying startup funding," which was adopted by startups from all over India.

New Enquiries



After attending an awareness session in her college, Ms. Aastha, a student at Govt P.G. College in Sector 14, Panchkula, expressed interest in the startup ecosystem and inquired about the incubation process on 4th November 2022. She discussed her concept for handcrafted gold-plated jewelry. She desired direction throughout the entire business-building process. We advised her to participate in the Ideakriti 2.0 Program to improve her clarity and turn her ideas into profitable ventures.

On 15th November 2022, we met Ayush, a student in the department of commerce at the Govt. PG College in sector 1 of Panchkula. Following a mentoring session with their department on November 15, 2022, Mr. Ayush and Taranjeet became fascinated by the startup ecosystem and seemed curious about how ideas are developed and implemented. We gave him a quick rundown of the startup ecosystem and described how we assist student entrepreneurs. We gave them a presentation on the services we provide for the students.



On 16th November 2022, I met Mr. Ayush, a walk-in student from the first year of the commerce department at Govt P.G. College, Sector 1. He was interested in the startup ecosystem and wanted to start his idea for creating a platform for the gig workforce in the local needs before expanding to a larger geographic area.



New Enquiries



A final-year commerce student is passionate about developing a platform for graphic designers and making them accessible to businesses that require these thoroughly skilled resources under one roof.

On 21st November 2022, Ms. Deepika, a student at Govt P.G. College in Sector 1, entered the incubator because she was interested in the startup ecosystem.

It is inspiring to hear about fresh business ideas from youngsters with aspirations of success. This expectation gave Ms. Sonu Kumari, a student at the Government P.G. college in Sector 1, the idea to produce handmade artwork. Sonu visited the incubator on 21st November 2022 to learn more about the support she can expect from the startup incubator housed within her college. Our team fully assisted her in understanding the various supports we offer, including funding assistance, mentoring, and psychological care.



A sizable number of students from the department of commerce came in with questions about starting businesses. One of these students, Mr. Aditya, paid a visit to the incubator on 21st November 2022 to discuss his Vegan Product Café. He noted how many animal lovers in the city increasingly needed Vegan products. He wants to open a vegan cafe because he has personally experienced scarcity. We assisted him in creating a business plan so that his vision would be more precise. We advised him to participate in the Ideakriti 2.0 Program to further his learning.

Tricity Women Entrepreneurs shine at CANNABLE 4.0

Chandigarh, Chandigarh Angels Network organized its flagship annual event, CANNABLE 4.0 to help entrepreneurs learn from serial entrepreneurs and pitch their ideas to angel investors.

The event saw over 300 startups from tricity and even from various parts of the country who shared their ideas and some of the local entrepreneurs, shortlisted by CAN, got the opportunity to pitch their startup ideas before the investors, as well interact with them in a mentoring session.

In a session for women entrepreneurs organised by the Punjab State Council of Science and Technology, some innovative business ideas were presented before a panel of experts and



investors.

Though the prospective angel investors would communicate with startups after sometime but the Punjab State Council of Science and Technology adjudged the best business pitches with Dr. Gowri Jayamurugan declared the winner with a cash prize of Rs.25,000

while runners up were Saina, a student entrepreneur working on artificial intelligence, Anubhi, founder of Terafac working on industrial automation and Munna Bhattacharya working in the health and wellness sphere.

In his keynote address, Prashant Pitti, co-founder of the

celebrated startup EaseMyTrip advised budding entrepreneurs that good ideas can grow even without funding, just as his enterprise EaseMyTrip was bootstrapped to a valuation of \$1 Billion. A number of serial entrepreneurs and angel investors presented insight into the funding process and addressed the

fundamental concern of startups and the theme of CANNABLE 4.0, "Demystifying Startup Funding".

Some of the entrepreneurs included Tej Kapoor, Managing Partner at IvyCap

Ajay Tewari, Director and Chairman of CAN said that there are over 65 angel investors in CAN WHO HAVE made key investments of over Rs.16 crores in 37 startups.

Alok Ramsisaria, Director of CAN said that the community of angel investors shall continue to have more initiatives to strengthen the startup ecosystem in the region and help startups grow and survive. Nitika Khurana, Head of Operations at CAN said events like CANNABLE.

Mentoring Sessions



On 15th November 2022, the Department of Commerce and Startup Incubator Cum Centre of Excellence, Govt. PG College Sector 1, Panchkula, organized a mentor session with two prominent entrepreneurs. Along with Mr. Sameer Sharma, founder of Uengage and Shoutlo, Mr. Harit Mohan - CEO and founder of Signicent LLP, VP of TIE Chandigarh, and a TEDx speaker.

Vineet Khurana, the CEO of SACC India, hosted a fireside chat with these entrepreneurs. More than 66 students studying commerce attended this session.
