EARN WHILE YOUR LEARN SCHEME

INTRODUCTION

The Higher Education Department of Haryana introduced the scheme of 'Earn While You Learn' for Govt. and Private Aided colleges in 2001. This novel scheme has been adopted by our institution for the benefit of meritorious and needy students to earn while learning so that they can continue their studies on their own.

OBJECTIVE

The initiative is having a three-pronged impact.

- Financial assistance
- hands-on-training while studying.
- work experience

In addition, the scheme also gives an opportunity to develop the spirit of work culture and confidence amongst the students.

ALLOCATION OF WORK

Under the scheme the selected students are employed for various college jobs in:

- Laboratories
- Library
- Administrative office
- For IT related work

Criteria for Engaging Students

The students are engaged through interview by the duly constituted committee of four to five faculty members in related works.

- Meritorious students are given priority over others and thereafter it is ensured that the priority is given to the needy students.
- For all these jobs, students are paid at the rate of Rs. 100 per hour subject to a maximum of six hours per week per student so that a student is able to earn Rs. 600 per week and Rs. 2400 per month.
