FEEDBACK FROM STUDENTS, PARENTS, TEACHERS AND ALUMNI

Action taken report of Students:

Around 93% students agree that the subject course helps them in developing their personality and is relevant for solution of local problems. In addition, around 90% felt that there is a need for more skill-based content in the current syllabus. This points to the steps that were taken in this direction such as: (a) Students were given extra reference books and e - content to grasp the subjects in a comprehensive manner. (b) Special guest lectures and audio-visual aids like PowerPoint presentations and movies were shown to the students to enhance their interest in various subjects so that the students could easily decide the subjects they would want to opt for at the post-graduate level. (c) Interactive sessions were held for different courses and themes for personality development.

Moreover, around 85% students also feel that the curriculum is in synchrony with employment needs.

Action taken report of Parents:

The admission process in the College is transparent was agreed to by about 85% parents. Around 80% of them agreed that their ward was improving her knowledge base through interaction with the faculty of the College and 92% expressed that their ward took active interest in attending online/offline classes.

Action taken report of Teachers:

Around 95% are satisfied with the syllabus and feel that it is is suitable to the course. The University had revised the syllabus from 2014 onwards. 97% of them, are of the view that the aims and objectives of the syllabus are well defined and clear to the teachers and students. 96% agree that the course content is followed by corresponding reference books/materials.

Action taken report of Alumni:








5. The syllabus creates interest to pursue post graduation. 430 responses




6. The Syllabus promotes Critical and analytical thinking. 430 responses




7. Curriculum Provides enough flexibility in terms of subject choices. 430 responses




