**Activity name** – Seminar on “Navigating Success in IT Industry” to celebrate Engineers Day.

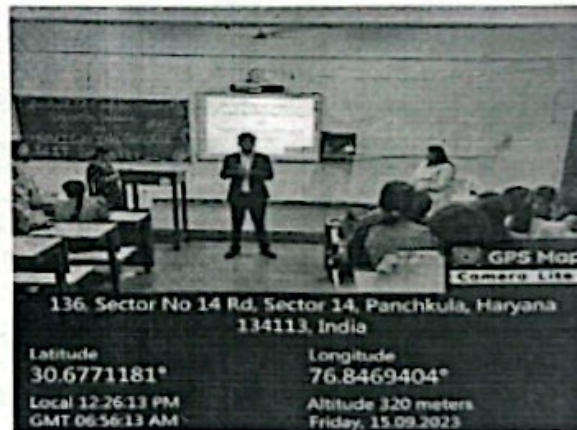
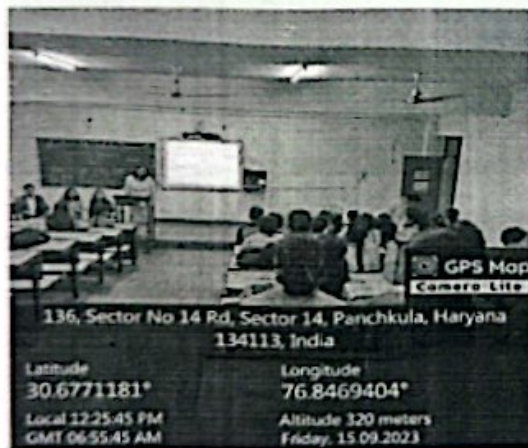

Students got an opportunity to sell their products which motivated them to work hard towards the creativity in their products. All students whole-heartedly participated in this activity.

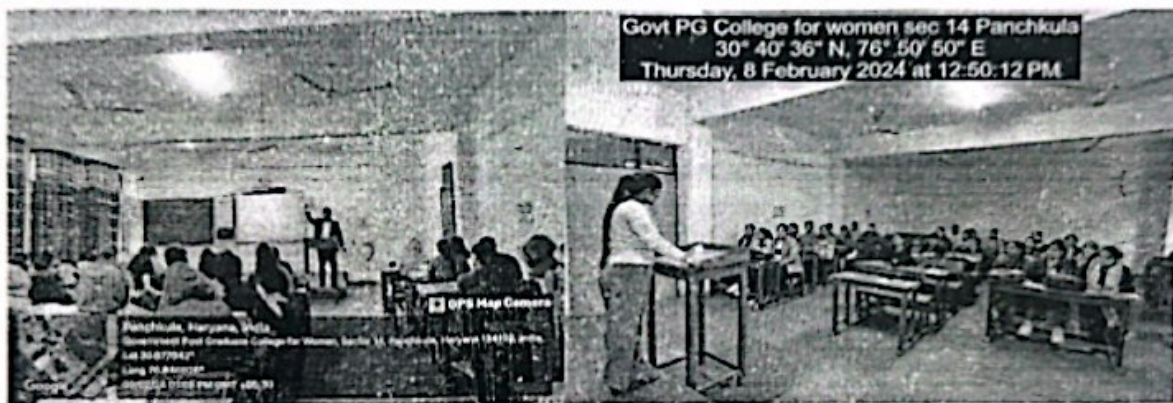

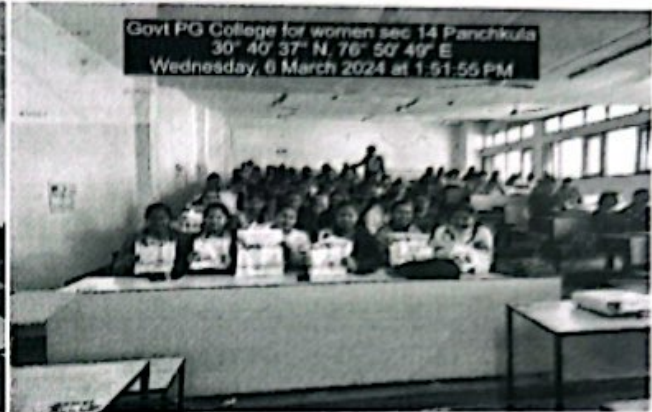
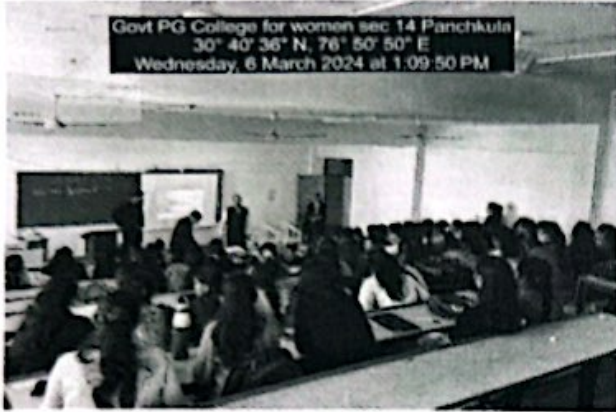
