Report

Women Studies and Development Cell in collaboration with Placement Cell, NAAC and IQAC organised a five day workshop, 'YOUTH PEACE PROGRAMME' by Youth Peace Foundation from 18.09.23 to 29.09.23. Each day comprised an interactive session on varied themes.

DAY 1 and 2: Topic – PEACE:-In this lecture, tried to make the students understand a different meaning of peace i.e. other than world peace, quiet place etc. The education program helped the students discover their own inner strength and personal peace. In this context, there was a series of videos shown such as: 'Where is Peace?', 'The Farmer and the Buried Treasure', 'A Voice for Peace', 'The Finest Achievement', 'Citizens of the Earth' and 'One Drop.'The main message via these visual aids was that the peace is within each person and if each human being takes responsibility for peace that is going to make a difference.

DAY 3 and 4: Topic – APPRECIATION:-On this day, the objective that was explored was that of appreciation. It was asserted that it is an inner resource that can help all of us enjoy what we have everyday. The videos that were shown on the day were: 'Peace is a feeling', '25,550 Days', 'Sharing a Dream', 'Appreciation', 'Welcome Each Day'. The main message was that maybe this life is really about the amazing journey that is happening. All we need to do is open our eyes, awaken and see, understand what is is - from our heart. All of us are probably supposed to be in contentment, appreciation and witnessing the most incredible of all miracles taking place.

DAY 5 and 6: Topic - INNER STRENGTH:-This session explored the innate quality of inner strength and its value in life. It was asserted that something inside of you is greater than all your goods and bads, regardless of how you see yourself, of how you portray your existence, of what you have read, of what you think, there is something that resides inside of you.

DAY 7 and 8: Topic - SELF AWARENESS:-On this day, the students were made aware of the strengths and resources that would help them become more self aware. It was stated that before you even get to tackle the job of making peace with yourself, it is important to answer the questions like, 'Who are you?', and 'what are you'?

DAY 8 and 9: Topic - CLARITY:-This session elaborated upon clarity as an inner resource that could be developed to help us in all aspects of life. Clarity is the most important human trait and component. During the interaction it was deduced that in this vehicle of existence, the most precious thing you have is your control and understanding intact.

DAY 9 and 10:-The last two days ended with a revision of all the topics discussed before. The students also shared their experiences of the programmeand their opinions on the objectives that were part of the sessions.

The WSDC, IQAC and the YPF concluded the programme with the installation of a "peace pillar" on the campus of the college. Each participant was also awarded with certificates.






