Financial Inclusion is the availability of equality of opportunity to access financial services. Banking sector plays an important role to make financial services accessible to everyone. Mr. Mohd. Shamim Divisional Manager Canara Bank, Mr. Nishant Bansal Branch Manager Canara Bank Sector-4 Panchkula along with his team members conducted the session. Mr. Mohd. Shamim highlighted the importance of financial inclusion in promoting economic growth, reducing poverty, and creating a more equitable society. He briefed about various products and services offered by the banking sector to promote financial inclusion, including: A zero-balance savings account for all, with no minimum balance requirement. A small savings account with a relaxation in the KYC norms. Kisan Credit Card: A credit facility for farmers to meet their agricultural and non-agricultural needs. Microfinance: Small loans for rural and urban poor, with a focus on women empowerment. Self-Help Group (SHG) Linkage: Providing loans to SHGs for income-generating activities. Financial Literacy Programmes: Educating customers on financial literacy and digital banking. Digital Banking: Mobile banking, internet banking, and UPI services for easy transactions. Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY): A comprehensive programme for financial inclusion, offering zero-balance accounts, insurance, and pension benefit and Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY): Loans up to ₹10 lakh for small businesses and entrepreneurs. Mrs Nishant Bansal and his team also briefed about Canara Aspire account, Canara Angel account which are specifically beneficial for the students. Total 67 student participants, placement cell members and other faculty members attended the session.
