Language lab:- The College has set up an English Language Laboratory equipped with teaching software provided by the Department of Education, Haryana, and supported with LAN networking. The lab consists of 26 computers and can accommodate 25 students at a time. Its primary objective is to enhance digital communication skills, strengthen employability, and improve students' proficiency in advanced communicative English. Instructor, Mrs. Neha, manages the lab with latest update.

To meet this need, the College has established four fully equipped computer laboratories with 143 computers, along with a dedicated IT Lab for Commerce comprising 12 computers. 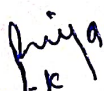
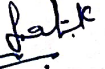
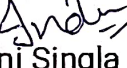
