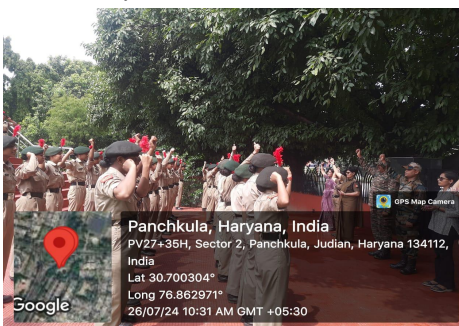


National Cadets Corps (NCC)

Annual Summary Report (Session 2024-2025)

1. Celebration of Kargil Divas on 26 July 2024 a event organized at Sector-2 Panchkula. Cleanliness of Major Sandeep Sankhla statue and surrounding area was done on this occasion by the NCC cadets under the supervision of NCC Incharge and staff sent from One Haryana Girls NCC Battalion, Ambala Cantt. 9

2. 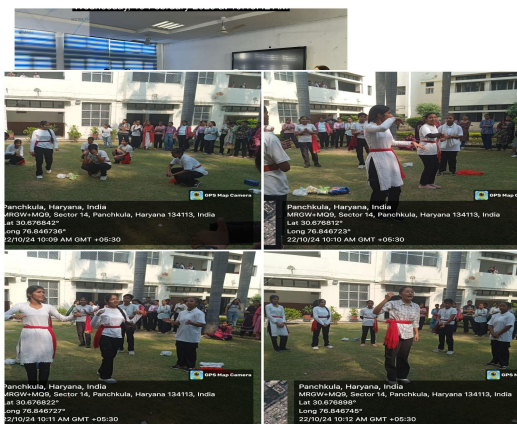

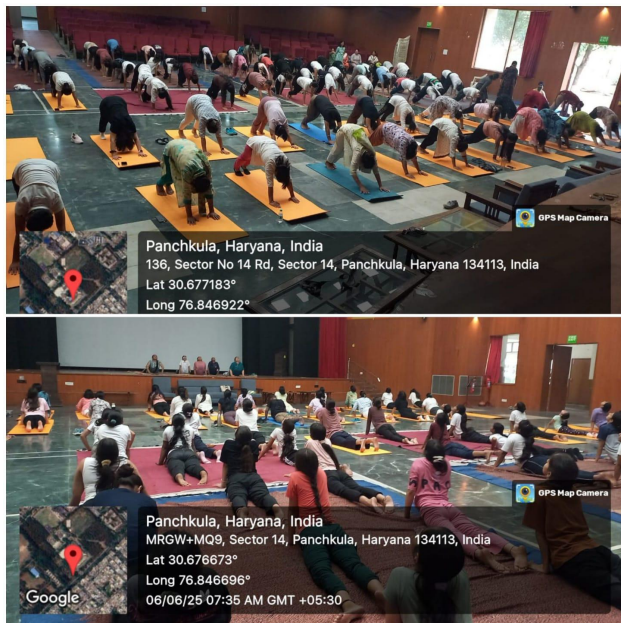
16. A awareness program was organised on 'Emergency Preparedness' in college campus in collaboration with NSS. 20 NCC cadets participated in this program.
