

Teacher's feedback

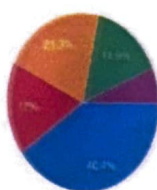
Feedback on various aspects of NEP2020 and curriculum is sought from 47 faculty members. The aspects such as coverage of both theoretical and practical aspects in the syllabus, course content, curriculum enhanced employability etc were covered. As teachers play a pivotal role in designing and implementing the curriculum, the inputs received from their feedback was taken into consideration for further necessary action.

More than 78% encourages the use of ICT tools such as smart classrooms, multimedia etc. 70.2% agreed that curriculum under NEP is flexible and multidisciplinary. More than 63% that current syllabus increased their knowledge in their subject. The college has good infrastructural facilities.

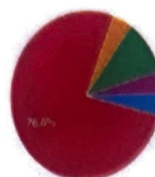

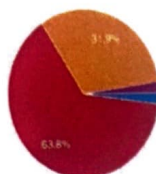

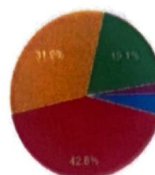

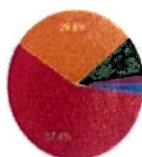

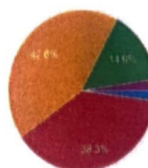

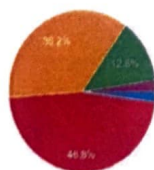

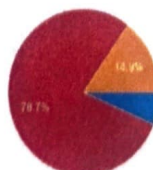

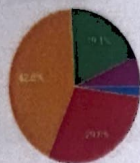

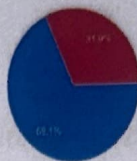
