

FEEDBACK REPORT 2025-26

Introduction

Feedback is an essential part of the learning process. The institution collects feedback on curriculum aspects and courses from students, alumni, faculty, and parents through online Google Forms, and the responses are analysed to improve the teaching-learning environment.

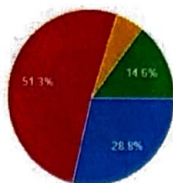
For the academic year 2025 - 26, feedback was collected from around 452 students regarding the curriculum and teaching-learning process. Most students agreed that the syllabus is completed on time and that teachers communicate effectively. Around 80% rated the student-teacher relationship as good or very good, and more than 80% felt that the Placement Cell, ED Cell, and Women Cell support personality development. College facilities such as the library, sports, cultural activities, canteen, parking, water, and first aid were also rated good or very good by most students. Many students also reported that lab experiences and practical exposure enhanced their understanding of concepts.

Feedback Analysis Report

1. The analysis of students' feedback indicates a high level of satisfaction with the teaching-learning process, timely completion of syllabus, and effective communication by faculty members.
2. A positive and healthy student-teacher relationship is reflected, contributing to an encouraging academic environment.
3. Support services such as the Placement Cell, Entrepreneurship Development Cell, and Women Cell are perceived as effective in enhancing students' personality development, confidence, and employability skills.
4. Academic infrastructure including libraries, laboratories, and ICT facilities has been well appreciated by students, indicating adequacy of learning resources.
5. Students have reported certain issues related to electricity supply, water availability, and cleanliness, which require attention for further improvement.

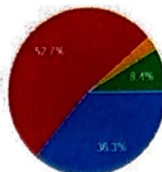

How teachers encourage students to participate in the class ?

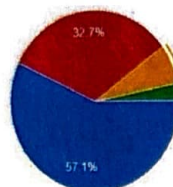

Is WhatsApp/Social Media faculty effective and informative in college ?

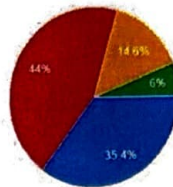

How do you rate the student-teacher relationship in your institution as a whole ?

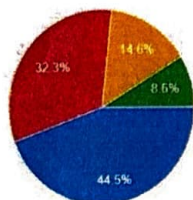

Does the curriculum/syllabi encourage you for higher education ?

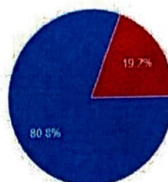

Does the Placement cell, Entrepreneurship cell and Women cell of your college help in the personality development ?

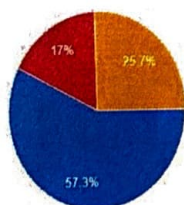

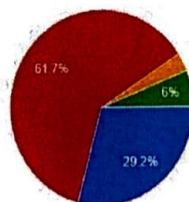

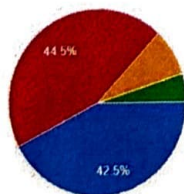

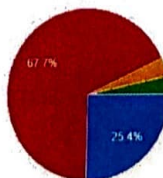

What is your opinion regarding Issue/Return procedure of books in college library ?

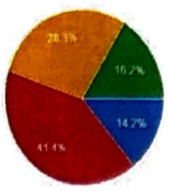

What are your views regarding the basic facilities (water, canteen, cleanliness, electricity etc.) in your college ?

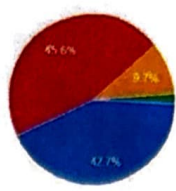

Did college conduct various extra curricular activities (like sports,cultural etc) time-to-time ?

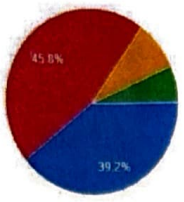

What are your views regarding office staff cooperation in your college ?

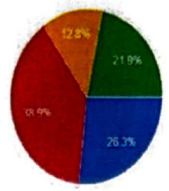

How do you rate the basic First Aid/Sanitary Pads/Pain Killers (Dispensary)facilities provided by the college ?

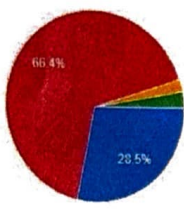

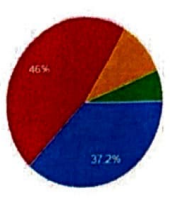

Does your Institution encourage you to learn new life skills like (Martial Arts/Yoga/Disaster Management) ?

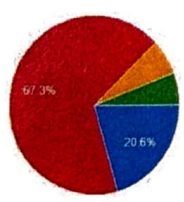

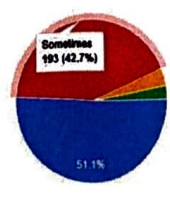

Do the teachers illustrate the educational concepts through examples and applications ?

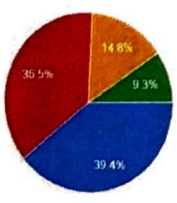

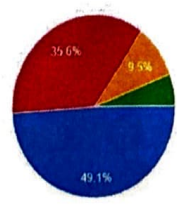

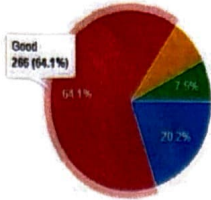
Do the teachers encourage you to participate in extra-curricular activities (NSS, NCC, sports etc)?

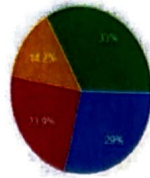

Parent Feedback

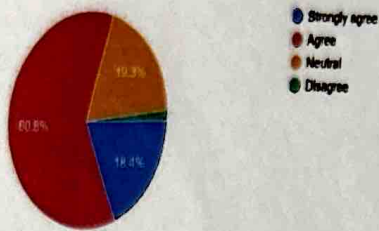
The parent feedback is designed to get a formative feedback from parents. For the academic year 2025–2026, parent's feedback is sought from around 367 parents about the curriculum and teaching-learning process. Majority of them agreed that syllabus is covered on time, teachers communicate thoroughly/effectively. 85% of them rate students-teacher relationship as good as and very good. More than 90% agreed that there is regular observation of ward. More than 75% parents agreed that Hostel Facilities are good and very good.

More than 80% agreed that the atmosphere in college is conducive for learning, College website is very informative. More than 80% agreed that there is regular observation of ward.

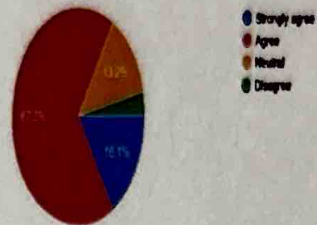
Feedback Analysis Report

3. It is observed that few of them expressed the admission process and discipline, classes held regularly in the college is very good/good.

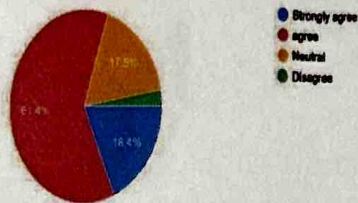

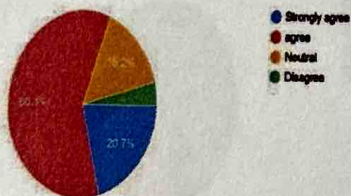

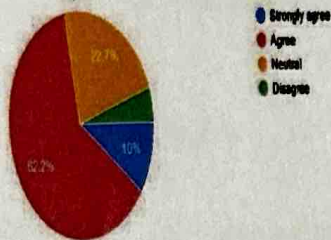

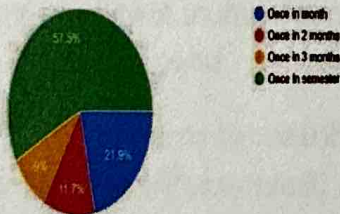
The changes introduced in the college in recent years are progressive.



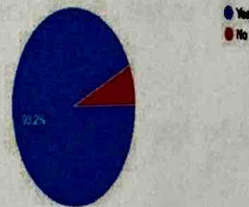
Teachers are making efforts to make teaching effective

Alumni Feedback

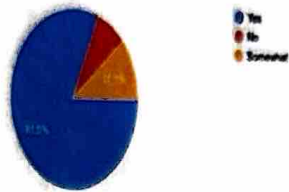

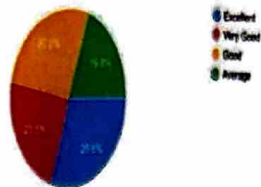
Feedback Analysis Report

1. Analysis shows that more than 81.5% alumni are satisfied with the efforts taken by the college to connect with them.
2. Majority of them rated infrastructure, lab and library facilities excellent.

4. Majority of them wants to contribute towards the development of the college by offering internships/Placements.
5. 46.9% alumni agree that they feel proud to be the alumni of this college.
6. 58% of them are keen to be connecting with other alumni for both personal and professional needs.
7. Majority of them agree that curriculum motivates them for further studies and career development and will further refer this college to their siblings and relatives etc.
8. Majority of Hostel alumni rated safety and other facilities in the hostel as excellent and food facilities as good.

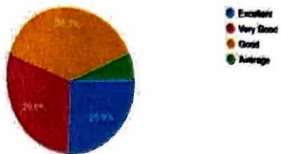
Are you satisfied with the efforts taken by the college to connect with its Alumni?

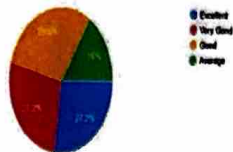
Rate the infrastructure, lab facilities and library in the College?

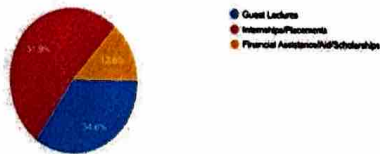
Rate the Admission process in the College?

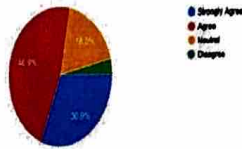
Are you satisfied with the extra curricular activities in the College?

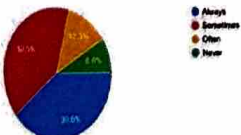

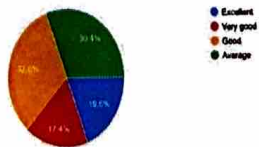
Does the curriculum motivates you for further studies, career development?

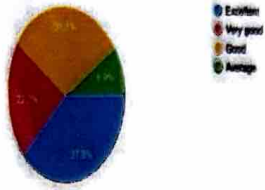
Do you further refer to this college to your siblings, relatives or anyone?

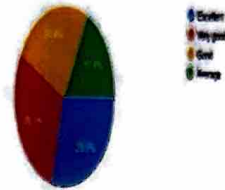
How would you rate food facilities in the Hostel? (For Hostel Alumni only)

Teacher's Feedback

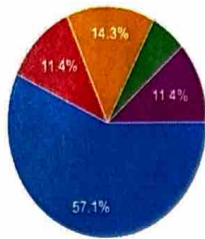
Teacher's aspects of NEP 2020 and curriculum are sought from 45 Teachers. Both aspects in the syllabus/courses contain curriculum enhancement, employability, etc. As teachers play a central role in designing and implementing the curriculum, the inputs received from their feedback were taken into consideration for the necessary action:

- More than 57% teachers agree that syllabus should be introductory only.
- They feel that curriculum under NEP is flexible for the students to get their choices.
- The course and syllabi have a good balance, it is agreed by 65% of teachers.
- 71.4% teachers agree that the use of ICT such as smart class and rooms and multimedia etc. encourages the students to come in class.

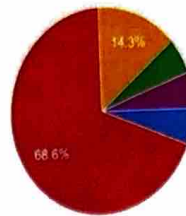
- The analysis of teachers' feedback reflects the education availability of teaching-learning facilities.

1. What do you think about the curriculum designed for Minor/SEC/VAC/MDC (in NEP 2020)?



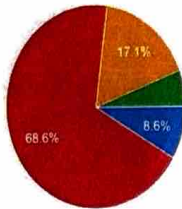

2. How would you rate the flexibility of the curriculum under NEP in terms of student choice and multi-disciplinary learning?



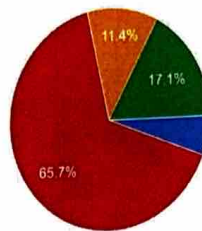

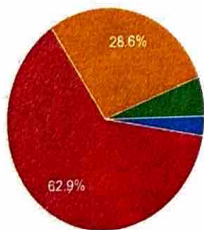

4. The course and syllabus have a good balance between theory and practical?



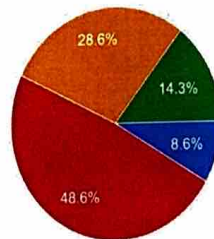

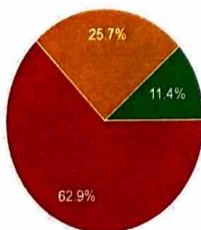

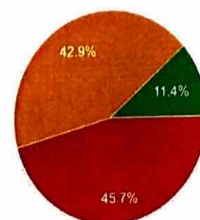

7. Are the aspects of NEP Policy like curricular reforms, multilingual education, holistic education, skill based education fulfilled?



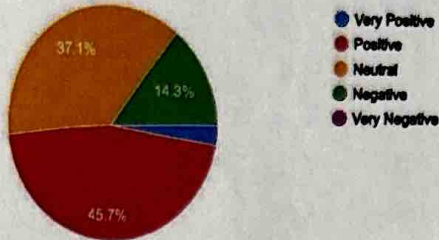

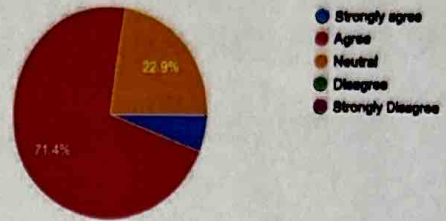

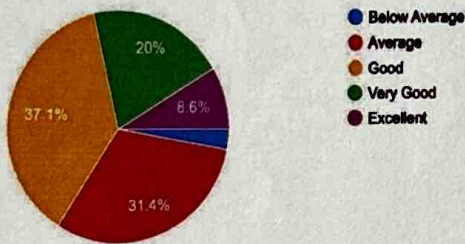
9. Overall how would you rate the impact of NEP on the quality of education?



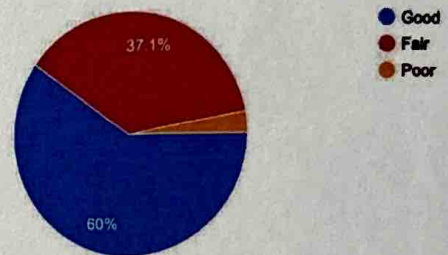

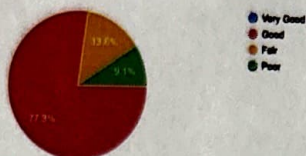

Non-Teaching Feedback

The Non-Teaching Feedback Form analysis shows that most staff members rated the college facilities positively. About 77.3% rated infrastructure as good, while smaller percentages rated it fair (13.6%) or poor (9.1%). For facilities like canteen, internet, and Wi-Fi, 72.7% rated them good. Training programs are provided sometimes (50%) and often (27.3%). Additionally, 77.3% staff are aware of Haryana Civil Service Rules.

Key suggestions include improving toilets, drinking water facilities, installing air conditioners in labs, and improving internet services.

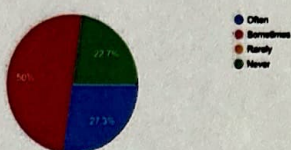
How you will rate Infrastructure facilities (space, ventilation, lighting, toilet etc.) in college?
